Last year when the Covid pandemic ensued we were forced to suspend our children's church and move outdoors. Though this last November we were able to move into a storefront property, because of limited space we were unable to restart our children's services.

Last month we held a Spring Building Campaign and during that time we were able to start once again holding children's services. – Praise the LORD! In addition, we had 3 new families start coming during this Spring Program and we were able to see 46 people saved in door-to-door soulwinning over the course of the 4 week spring campaign.

We also this month have transitioned our youth meetings from once a month to every Sunday evening before service.

Many of our once regular families that had not been since we moved into our building have come back to visit during these last two months. We have seen many first time visitors, many baptized and many begin attending regularly. I believe the one things for which I am most thankful is that –at the time of this writing - since January 1<sup>st</sup> of this year our people have led 137 people to Christ in door-to-door soulwinning. God has blessed us richly during the first several months of this year and we look forward to giving another fruitful update in weeks to come.
