Our kids (Megan and Caleb) were so excited to see children from the community come, as previously they have been the only kids in attendance. Julie was able to have a separate Bible lesson for the kids in conference room B while the adults met in the adjoining room. Please continue to pray for contacts in the county, and for this group, as the Lord gathers the nucleus of His church here in Palmyra. Pray for Kevin and his family, as well as for Patti, who are our most recent visitors.

Preparation for the Church Plant

The map campaign mentioned in the last letter continues as a systematic effort to get the gospel out in the area around Palmyra. The members of our home church are picking up maps and delivering flyers with information about the Bible study and the plan of salvation. We had the wonderful experience of running out of flyers and needing to order more! In addition, one of the members of Albemarle Baptist who lives in the gated community of Lake Monticello, put us on the permanent guest list. That gives us the freedom to go into this gated community regularly to put flyers in the newspaper boxes.
